

**IOWA TROPHY BUCK
PROCEDURES FOR TROPHY ANTLER COMPETITION**

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY - KEEP INSTRUCTIONS WITH YOU

GENERAL:

Deadline for antlers to be scored for competition is 1:00 PM Sunday.

Antlers removed from the facility before awards are presented on Sunday are automatically disqualified and cannot win awards. Your antlers must be present on Sunday at approximately 3:00 PM to receive awards. Those antlers not in the running for awards may be removed after scoring is done. All antlers must be picked up by 4:00 PM on Sunday.

PROCEDURES FOR ANTLERS WINNING AWARDS:

If your trophy is an Award Winner -

1. You may check with the registration desk for updated standings to see if your rack may be an award winner.
2. Awards will be displayed with winning racks by 3:00 PM Sunday.

RELEASE OF ANTLERS:

Release for non-winning entries will begin at 2:00 PM. Non-winning entries will be released before winning entries. Proceed as follows:

1. Present your **GREEN** Re-entry Pass/Claim Check form at the registration desk.
2. A contest official will give you the location of your antlers on the display boards.
3. Take your **GREEN** Re-entry Pass/Claim Check form to the display board where your trophy is displayed and show them to a deer contest worker stationed there.
4. The deer contest worker will remove your antlers and give them to you.
5. You must then go back to the registration desk with your trophy antler entry to sign out.
This is for your protection and ours.
6. You may now leave the show with your trophy antler entry. **You must leave through the Southwest exit.**

LIMITED EARLY REMOVAL:

Absolutely no trophies, antlers, or deer heads can be released between noon and 2 PM on Sunday.

If you must remove your antlers prior to noon on Sunday, present your **GREEN Claim Check** form at the registration desk. Checkouts will be one at a time and will take time due to the amount of contest records that need to be adjusted.

Also, note that if your trophy is removed before normal checkout time, you will not be eligible for the deer contest awards.
